HERE IS SOME GOOD NEWS FOR OWNERS. **OUR VILLAGE ON THE GREEN (VOG) COMMUNITY IS IN A “NO EVACUATION” ZONE.**

- ON THE PINELLAS COUNTY EVACUATION MAPS, THE VOG LOCATION IS IN THE WHITE AREA. WHITE MEANS **“NO EVACUATION REQUIRED”**.
- YOU CAN ACCESS THESE MAPS AND ALSO EMERGENCY SHELTER INFORMATION ONLINE AT WWW.PINELLASCOUNTY.ORG. WHEN YOU GET TO THAT HOME PAGE, CLICK ON “EMERGENCY INFORMATION”. - ON THAT WEBSITE YOU CAN ALSO SIGN UP FOR THE FOLLOWING: RECEIVE ALERTS ABOUT EMERGENCIES AND OTHER IMPORTANT NEWS BY SIGNING UP FOR [ALERT PINELLAS](#), A FREE EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SERVICE FOR PINELLAS COUNTY RESIDENTS. IT ALLOWS YOU TO SIGN UP TO RECEIVE URGENT MESSAGES ON A VARIETY OF SITUATIONS, SUCH AS SEVERE WEATHER, BOIL WATER NOTICES, MISSING PERSONS, OR EVACUATIONS.
- DURING AN EMERGENCY IF YOU SHOULD LOSE INTERNET/WiFi/CABLE CAPABILITY, AND YOU NEED INFORMATION, YOU CAN USE YOUR CELL PHONE OR HOUSE PHONE TO CALL **THE CITIZEN INFORMATION CENTER AT (727) 464-4333**.
- KEEP THIS IN MIND: DURING A HURRICANE, **ELECTRICITY WILL GO OUT**, SOMETIMES FOR SEVERAL DAYS. HAVING A BATTERY-OPERATED RADIO CAN HELP YOU STAY INFORMED ON THE STATUS OF YOUR LOCAL COMMUNITY.
